

# REFOREST THE RED

**WHAT:** Help plant 1,000 trees and shrubs along the Red River in celebration of Arbor Day!

**WHY:** Development and cultural practices have prevented natural regeneration of trees along the banks of the river. Planting trees in key areas along the Red will create a buffer to maintain river bank stability, encourage the growth of native plants, improve water quality (F-M's drinking water source!), and provide habitat for river wildlife.



**WHO:** You, your family, friends, and/or associates. For safety reasons we ask that one adult be present for every five children.

**HOW:** A short training will be held at various times throughout the day. Volunteers will dig holes, plant, mulch, and water.

**WHAT TO WEAR:** Long pants, closed toed flat shoes, and gloves that can get muddy.

**WHAT TO BRING:** If you have shovel, bring it with your name written on the handle.
