



Public Access Sites on the Red River

Wahpeton, ND

Off US Highway 75 to Minnesota Avenue in Breckenridge; west on Minnesota Avenue to the Red River: Public boat launching site, public fishing pier and bank fishing areas.

Wells Memorial Park: Concrete boat launch ramp, parking and pier.

Moorhead, MN

M.B. Johnson Park, about ½ mile north of the Crystal Sugar processing plant: Public boat launching site with bituminous-surface parking area for 15-20 car-trailer units and a bituminous-surface access to a double concrete plank ramp. No dock or services.

Fargo, ND

Bank fishing at: Convent Landing (52nd Ave. S.), Dike East, El Zagal Park, Fargo water treatment plant, Lemke Park, Lindenwood Park, Middle Dam, North Dam, Oak Grove Park, Trollwood Park and Veterans Hospital.

Norman County Road 25, MN

1 mile west of MN Highway 75 on Norman County Road 25, near Hendrum: Public boat launching site with asphalt parking surface for 8-10 car-trailer units. Concrete plank ramp. No dock or services.

Halstad Municipal Park, MN

1 mile west of MN Highway 75 on MN Highway 200: Bank fishing and earthen boat ramp; picnic area with water, shelter and sanitary facilities.

Buxton, ND

Belmont Park: Concrete ramp and bank fishing. Camping, water and toilets available.

East Grand Forks, MN

Off Hill Street at Central Avenue: Public boat launching site; full service municipal park facility with camping, electric and water hook ups, sanitary facilities and picnic area; gravel parking lot for many vehicles; dock adjacent to ramp.

Lafave Park: Bank fishing.

Grand Forks, ND

East of State Mill Road approximately 1.5 miles north of US Highway 2: Concrete ramp and bank fishing.

Downstream of the Riverside Dam, east of State Mill Road on Red Dot Place: Bank fishing area

Central and Lincoln Park: Bank fishing.

Oslo, MN

MN Highway 1 bridge near water tower: Boat launching and bank fishing; bituminous surfaced parking lot for 10-12 car-trailer units; concrete ramp with floating dock; no services.

Drayton, ND

Drayton dam: Concrete ramp and bank fishing. East of Drayton city water tower: Concrete ramp and bank fishing.

MN Highway 175 Crossing

10 miles west of Hallock on Highway 175 on the north side of the highway bridge: Public boat launching and bank fishing site; bituminous-surface parking area for 15 car-trailer units; concrete plank ramp; no services.

Pembina, ND

Pembina city campground: Concrete ramp, dock, and bank fishing area. Campground located at the confluence of the Pembina and Red Rivers.
