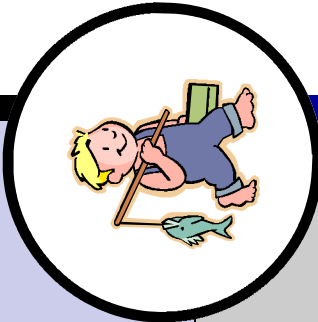


More recreation events on June 6:

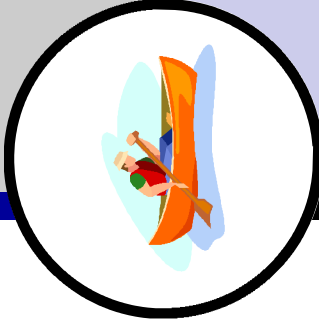

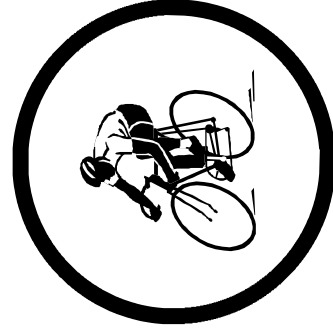
