

PADDLING OPPORTUNITIES AT HJEMKOMST LANDING

CANOE & KAYAK RENTALS

Experience the Red River in downtown Moorhead without transporting your own vessel.

LOCATION

The Rental Shack at Hjemkomst Landing in the Hjemkomst Center parking lot, 202 1st Ave N, Moorhead. Vessel rental is for use at Hjemkomst Landing only.

HOURS OF OPERATION

May 27 - September 6 (closed July 4) Tuesdays and Thursdays 4 - 8 pm Saturdays 11 am - 6 pm Sundays noon - 6 pm

COST

\$10/hour/vessel, prorated after the first hour.

INDIVIDUAL RENTALS

Single and tandem kayaks and canoes are available on a first-come first-served basis. Rentals include paddles and life jackets.

GROUP RENTALS

Available outside of regular rental hours for a \$100 minimum rental fee, dependent on staff availability. Reservations must be made at least 14 days in advance by calling 218.299.5078.

RIVER PADDLING EXCURSIONS

A leisurely paced group paddle with local experts sharing their Red River knowledge. All skill levels welcome!

Moorhead Parks and Recreation is renting 12 seasonal canoe or kayak storage spots on a first-come, firstserved basis. Renters provide their own locks and are responsible for removing vessels in case of impending flooding.

KAYAKING ADVENTURES AT LINDENWOOD PARK

Discover the thrill of kayaking with the Fargo Park District at Lindenwood Park! The journey begins with a scenic trail portage to the Red River, and returning the kayak to the rental building completes your trip. To ensure everyone can experience the Red River, wheeled kayak trolleys are offered to get the kayak to the water plus there is an adaptive kayak launch.

RENTALS

Glide through the water in 10-foot, 41-pound kayaks, available on a first-come, first-served basis for \$10/hour. Kayaks are equipped with a life jacket and paddle. Anyone over the age of 12 can join the fun, but the rental agreement must be signed by an adult.

Fargo-Moorhead Water Trail Map has information on access, river miles, portages around dams, and safety.





Minnesota Department of Natural Resources has maps and information for the six paddling segments of the Red River which includes real-time river levels interpreted for paddling on a scale ranging from "scrapable" to "very high".



All skill levels welcome for this FUN flag race where each paddler chooses between 1.5, 3.5 or 6 miles. Participants paddle up river to a designated turnaround point, grab a prize, and return down river to finish.
